## BUSH FIRE DANGER PERIOD

## Permits required from 1 OCTOBER 2020

The Bush Fire Danger Period runs from 1 October to 31 March.

The permit issuing officer may add additional conditions as necessary, but standard conditions are:

- The permit is to be carried out by the permit holder, or another person at all times at the site of the fire;
- The fire must be supervised at all times;
- Notifications must be given to the Cooma Fire Control Centre, and adjoining neighbours at least 24 hours prior to the fire being lit; and
- The permit may be varied, cancelled or suspended depending on weather conditions.

# Training

## Second Saturday of the month at 2:00pm

Training has resumed on the second Saturday of each month, 2:00pm at the Colinton Fire Shed.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the NSW RFS has provided the following information regarding safe practices:

Meetings, training and events may continue, provided COVIDSafe practices are in place and adhered to. COVIDSafe practices mean:

If you are feeling unwell, you are not to attend a NSW RFS activity or location.

If you're unwell, stay home and get tested.

Consider whether the event can be held remotely to limit face-to-face interaction, especially if there's likely to be large groups or people who may be at higher risk of serious infection from COVID-19. If the activity or event is being held face-to-face, ensure appropriate physical distancing.

Limit the number of attendees in accordance with the capacity limits (number of people per square metre in an indoor area.)

For activities such as crews attending planned events, hazard reductions and incidents, limits to the number of crew per vehicle apply.
